Passenger bus catches fire on Hyderabad-Vijayawada highway:

Hyderabad: Passengers of a private bus had a narrow escape as it caught fire on the Hyderabad-Vijayawada highway in the early hours of Tuesday. The bus, which was going to Kandukur from Hyderabad, suddenly caught fire near Pittampally in Chityala mandal of Telangana's Nalgonda district. The driver noticed smoke coming out of the engine and immediately stopped the bus. He alerted the passengers, who all got down before the flames engulfed the vehicle. There were 29 passengers aboard the bus belonging to a private travel agency. The vehicle was completely gutted before a fire engine reached the spot to douse the flames. Police rushed to the spot and took up the investigation. The Telugu states have seen a series of road accidents involving buses during the last three weeks. A head-on collision between an RTC bus and a tipper truck in Telangana's Rangareddy district claimed 19 lives on 3 November.

Coimbatore couple ‘digitally arrested’ by cyber fraudsters:

Chennai: Panic spread through a quiet neighbourhood in Tamil Nadu's Coimbatore after a 65-year-old man and his wife were allegedly "digitally arrested" and confined inside their home for nearly two days by cybercriminals posing as officials from the Defence Ministry and Mumbai Police. The elderly couple, residents of Ramanathapuram, received a distressing phone call from a man claiming to be an official from the Ministry of Defence in Mumbai. The caller falsely alleged that the man's Aadhaar number was linked to bank transactions involving terrorist groups and said the matter was under investigation. To "verify" his financial records, the caller demanded details of the couple's bank accounts. Soon after, another individual appeared on a video call dressed in a police uniform and identified himself as an officer from the Mumbai Police cybercrime wing.

Kerala losing out on Central schemes due to state’s ‘apathy’, says BJP:

Kozhikode: Former Kerala BJP chief K. Surendran accused the state government of denying citizens the benefits of major Central schemes by "failing" to release its share of funds. Surendran said the PM Modi's flagship programme 'Jal Jeevan Mission', aimed at providing tap water to all households, was stalled in Kerala due to the state's inaction. "Centre has already sanctioned Rs 7600 crore, but the Kerala government has not released its matching contribution," he said. He alleged that similar negligence has affected several other Central projects. Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana-Urban which seeks to provide affordable housing, has made little progress, while the Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana, intended to improve rural connectivity, has been delayed. He said that even though the Centre had declared major Kerala cities as Smart Cities, issues such as waterlogging in Thiruvananthapuram remain unresolved.

Statewide stir by DMK allies against SIR ahead of polls

Even as the DMK and its allies are battling against the ongoing Special Intensive Revision (SIR) of electoral rolls in Tamil Nadu, the parties on Tuesday staged massive protest demonstrations across the State to condemn the exercise as an attempt at mass deletion of voters to favour the BJP.

Protests were also a show of strength and solidarity among the allies of the DMK-led Secular Progressive Front, comprising the Congress, VCK, Left Parties, MDMK, the Muslim parties, and others. Apart from senior DMK functionaries, MPs and MLAs, TNCC president K Selvaperunthagai, VCK leader Thol Thirumavalavan, MP; Vaiko, MP of MDMK; P Shanmugham of CPI(M), and his CPI counterpart M Veerapandian took part in the protest demonstrations.

In the coastal Thoothukudi, it was MP Kanimozhi, the DMK's Parliamentary Party leader and the party's Deputy General Secretary, who led the demonstration. "In total disregard of the opposition to this SIR from the very beginning by the DMK and other opposition parties, the EC is implementing it in an autocratic manner. We are not opposed to the SIR, but demand that it should not be done in a tearing hurry when a few months are left for the assembly

election. The EC is acting as the handmaiden of the BJP-led Union Government, and the SIR will result in the disenfranchisement of a vast majority of minorities, Dalits, and those engaged in agriculture," she said.

Supporters and functionaries of the DMK and its alliance partners in thousands, carrying placards, demanding that the Election Commission give up the SIR, took part in the protests held at all the District headquarters.

Chief Minister and DMK president MK Stalin, elated at the huge success of the state-wide protests, in an 'X' post said, "Preventing the SIR is the major task before us. On the one hand, we are carrying a legal battle against the SIR, which attempts to strip the voting right, the very foundation of democracy, and on the other, we are launching the struggle on the ground. We have launched #WarRoom #Helpline to help prevent the confusion in SIR. We, the Secular Progressive Front, will carry on the struggle to protect our right to vote and fight the great danger that is SIR."

Sabarimala gold heist: SIT arrests former Devaswom Commissioner N Vasu

The Special Investigation Team (SIT) probing the Sabarimala temple gold heist case arrested N. Vasu, former Devaswom Commissioner and President of the Travancore Devaswom Board (TDB), on Tuesday.

Vasu is the third accused in the case. He was taken into custody after being questioned by the SIT for two consecutive days and will be produced before the Ranni court. Other officials arrested earlier reportedly stated that they acted under Vasu's instructions.

According to the SIT, it was N. Vasu, then Devaswom Commissioner, who directed officials to record that the gold-plated layers on the Dwarapalaka sculptures and the sanctum sanctorum (Sreekovil) door frames at the Sabarimala shrine were made of copper.

Vasu became the President of the Travancore Devaswom Board (TDB) in November 2019. He had served as the Devaswom Commissioner from 1 February, 2018, to 31 March, 2019.

His arrest marks a major

development in the high-profile case involving the alleged theft of gold used for plating the temple's sanctum sanctorum doors and Dwarapalaka idols at the Sabarimala temple in 2019. Opposition Leader V.D. Satheesan had earlier alleged that Vasu was close to CM Pinarayi Vijayan and the CPI-M. He claimed that with Vasu's arrest, ministers and CPI-M leaders linked to the Sabarimala gold loot would also come under scrutiny.

So far, the prime accused Unnikrishnan Potty, former Sabarimala Administrative Officer Murari Babu, former Executive Officer Sudheesh Kumar, and former TDB Thiruvabharanam Commissioner K.S. Biju have been arrested in connection with the case.

The case pertains to the alleged theft of gold from the gold-plated door frames and Dwarapalaka idols at the Sabarimala temple's sanctum sanctorum.

The Kerala High Court, which is monitoring the SIT investigation, recently granted permission for a scientific examination to determine the extent of gold loss.

Chief Minister Stalin’s Kolathur constituency has 4,379 fake voters, alleges Nirmala Sitharaman

Debunking the protests by the ruling DMK and its allies across Tamil Nadu against the Special Intensive Revision (SIR) of electoral rolls as a diversionary tactic to conceal the Stalin government's failure, BJP leader and Union Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman on Tuesday claimed that the Chief Minister's assembly constituency in Chennai itself had 4,379 fake voters.

"The SIR exercise is being carried out to remove fake voters only. But Chief Minister MK Stalin is deriding it as a conspiracy. Even in his Kolathur constituency, there are 4,379 fake voters. Deputy Chief Minister Udhayanidhi doesn't even know what the SIR is about, and the DMK protest is an attempt to hoodwink the people," she said, while addressing the media, after participating in the Zonal Core-Committee meeting of the BJP in Coimbatore.

"No genuine voter will be removed or disenfranchised," she asserted, and asked the Opposition parties whether no SIR had been held earlier. "SIR had been held 10 times before the year 2000 and thrice after that. While SIR is a revision, Udhayanidhi claims it is a 'restriction' and the DMK paints a picture as though the BJP had imposed it. It had

happened when the DMK was sharing power at the Centre," countered the Finance Minister, while defending the SIR exercise.

Maintaining that the ECI is constitutionally mandated under Articles 324 and 329 to revise the electoral rolls ahead of every election, she said: "Of the 4,379 fake voters in Kolathur, 933 had bogus addresses and 30 shared the same address.

There are over 7 lakh duplicate voters, 20 lakh fake entries, and 35 lakh migrated voters, taking the total number of ineligible entries in the State to 68 lakh." She then asked: "Should not such fake voters and ineligible entries be removed?"

The Finance Minister accused the DMK and other opposition parties of weakening statutory

and constitutional institutions, saying they blame the EVMs whenever the BJP wins and are now targeting the EC. Responding to a question on Rahul Gandhi's 'Vote Chori' expose, she dismissed the Congress leader's claims, saying: "He shouts 'Vote Chori' by twisting facts, be it Bihar, Haryana, or Maharashtra. It is the fear of losing the elections."

CM Reddy calls for Padma award for departed Telangana poet Ande Sri

Telangana Chief Minister A Revanth Reddy on Tuesday appealed to BJP leaders and Union ministers G Kisan Reddy and Bandi Sanjay Kumar to confer Padma Sri on Telugu poet Ande Sri, who passed away yesterday.

He said that the state government would write to the Centre urging it to confer



the award on the poet who inspired the statehood movement with his numerous songs, particularly the state

anthem "Jaya, Jayahe Telangana". The chief minister, who participated in the last rites of the departed poet, lamented that the state government had written to the Centre last year too but received no response. Participating in the funeral at Ghatkesar, he carried the bier in the last journey of the poet. Later, he announced a memorial to be built in memory of Ande Sri and promised a

government job to a family member.

He recalled the significant role played by the great poet during the statehood movement through his songs and poems. He even appealed to the two Union ministers for their cooperation to recognise his contribution. "Let both the state and Central governments strive for the Padma award to the great 'Telangana writer,'" said Reddy.
