Market Opportunity: The market opportunity should be clearly defined and should show a potential for growth.	10
Revenue Model: The revenue model should be clearly explained and should show a potential for generating revenue.	10
Competition: The competition should be clearly identified, and the solution should show how it is better than or different from existing solutions.	10
engaging, clear, and concise. The pitch deck should be well-designed and easy to follow	15
Q&A: The participant's ability to answer questions from the judges should be evaluated. The participant should be able to demonstrate a good understanding of their solution, market, and competition.	15
Overall Impact: The overall impact of the pitch deck should be evaluated. The solution should show potential for creating value, making an impact, and addressing a significant problem.	20

Rules:

- Each branch of ICAI can organize its own Pitch Deck Competition.
- Participants will need to submit their pitch deck by a specified deadline.
- The pitch deck must follow the specified format (as per Annexure A) and include key elements such as the problem being solved, the solution, market opportunity, revenue model, and competition.
- The branch-level competition will be judged by a panel of judges appointed by the branch.
- First Winning Team at the Branch-level competition will qualify for the regional-level competition.
- Each team will be given 15 mins. time to present their idea, followed by 5 mins of Q&
