

### Message from Chairman, EIRC

In an endeavour to improvise the Scheme of Education and Training for CA course, the Board of Studies of ICAI has been organizing Outreach Programme for the proposed scheme at various levels of the Institute. The Managing committees of branches are requested to conduct virtual/physical sessions and to ensure maximum participation of members, students, academicians and other stakeholders in order to appraise them about the new proposed scheme and obtain their feedback on the same. 


